

Guidelines for Submission of Manuscripts

Contributions are accepted in Khmer, English and French. All articles are referred by members of the Advisory Board or other recognized scholars in the field. Article manuscripts should not exceed 40 double-spaced pages. Consult issues of the journal as a guide to format. All contribution propositions should be submitted both in print and on disk in MS Word PC programs. Please indicate on the disk the program used, as well as file and author names. Manuscripts should be accompanied by photocopies of illustrations. Original illustrations are to be submitted only when articles are selected for publication. Diacritics should not be used in the main text; authors should instead include, as a separate document, a list of words with diacritics. Manuscripts should be sent to:
